





What we've achieved – Infrastructure

eHGV Charging £1m

Port of Tilbury eHGV rapid charging hub, is a clean fuel hub on A13 to London.

The charging hub has 16 rapid chargers and has received £1m in funding from the UK Government.

The hub has been strategically designed and located for large fleets.



5G Infrastructure £3m

Faster, reliable 5G for homes, schools and local businesses.

Safer, smoother transport, real-time traffic and freight data.

Local jobs and digital skills as businesses adopt next-gen tech, deployed across all 3 tax sites.



Connectivity Lab £1.3m

Attract the best innovation from around the world.

148 applications received to increase 25% efficiency to port operations.

Testing in real world environment to be applied to public.



What we've achieved – Innovation

Three Innovation Labs have been launched, with focus on local priorities: better connectivity, improved health-care, better built homes and lower living costs.

Plans to retrofit first 50 homes in LBBD by April 26

The Connectivity Lab had 148 applications

59 applicants were shortlisted

20 companies pitched

10 companies to be selected

The aim of the trial is to identify solutions which can deliver a 25% efficiency
